# b. Ferry Ave Sidewalk Project

Engineer Mark Johnson of Varela Engineering was present to provide an update on the Ferry Ave Sidewalk Project. Due to estimated increased costs for construction, WSDOT and CDTC have awarded the Town of Coulee Dam an additional \$47,664, bring the total project to \$203,164. This is still a 100% grant funded project with no town matching funds required. Johnson informed the council that other projects are coming in around 30% higher for construction due to increased costs. With the additional funding, there are some requirements to move the project timeline up which means that town will need to act quickly. (m/s Rey/St. Jeor) to accept the additional funding. Motion carried.
